1. The Description of the Specific event

This e-Service is made available on this web page in order to offer an online electronic registration for the *Feed Conference 2016 Photo Contest*. While registering your personal data will be collected and further processed for the purposes detailed hereafter under point 2.

The specific e-Service is managed considering:

- Event organised by both the JRC and an external company inside the JRC
- Personal data are published on a publicly available website

As this e-Service collects and further processes personal data, Regulation (EC) 45/2001, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions/bodies and on the free movement of such data, is applicable.

The Head of Unit Thematic coordination of the Joint Research Centre (JRC) has taken the responsibility, as Controller of the processing of personal data covered by the generic notification DPO-1528. The specific e-Service is under the responsibility of Hendrik Emons, *Unit Head of the Directorate F – Health, Consumers and Reference Materials* of the Joint Research Centre (JRC), acting as Event Co-ordinator and Personal Data Processor.

With a view to the provisions of the said Regulation, furthermore, the following should be noted. The information will not be re-used for an incompatible purpose. The EU will only disclose information to third parties if that is necessary for the fulfilment of the purpose identified above. The EU will not divulge your personal data for direct marketing purposes.

2. What personal information do we collect, for what purpose and through which technical means?

Identification Data

The personal data collected and further processed are: First name, name, affiliation. Photographs/pictures of groups of participants and organizers may be taken and published in the context of the event and in the framework of the JRC activities.

Purpose

The purpose of the processing of personal data for the e-Service as well as for the Feed Conference 2016 Photo Contest is the management of the event, including management of participants, event follow-up, photographs/pictures.

Photographs and audiovisual footage may be taken during the event and published thereafter. By agreeing to this privacy statement, you also agree to have your photograph and/or audiovisual footage taken and published by the JRC after the event". For any specific query, the applicants can use the contact information point in the privacy statement.

Technical information

Personal data are normally collected through classical web forms and stored inside a database on JRC servers as soon as you click on the submit button.

Personal data are stored also on a computer of the external contractor who has to guarantee the data protection, confidentiality and security required by Regulation (EC) 45/2001.

3. Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

No personal data is transmitted to parties, which are outside the recipients and the legal framework mentioned.

Some of your personal data for the *Feed Conference 2016 Photo Contest* will be published on a publicly available website. Therefore, you need to opt-in when registering to this event in order to confirm your acceptance to this publication.

4. How do we protect and safeguard your information?

The collected personal data and all information related to the above mentioned event is stored on a computer of the external contractor who has to guarantee the data protection and confidentiality required by Regulation (EC) 45/2001.

5. How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

Special attention is drawn to the consequences of a delete request, in which case any trace to be able to contact you will be lost.

6. How long do we keep your data?

Your personal data is kept as long as follow-up actions to the above mentioned "event" are necessary with the regard to the purpose of the processing of personal data for the e-Service as well as for the "event" management. All personal data linked to the user account and not used for 5 years after the last "event" registration will be deleted.
